

**SWINOMISH INDIAN TRIBAL COMMUNITY  
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
SHORE POWER INSTALLATION  
SWINOMISH FISHERMANS DOCKS**

The Swinomish Indian Tribal Community (SITC) seeks proposals from qualified contractors with expertise in installation and testing of electrical shore power stations on commercial fishing docks. Qualified respondents will be considered for the following project.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

Work to be performed by the selected respondent consists of installation of overhead power supply to an existing conduit that will power 16 double shore power stations on the commercial fishing docks on the Swinomish Channel

The scope of work includes but is not limited to the following general items:

- Coordination with Swinomish Indian Tribal Community operations.
- Coordination with Puget Sound Energy to extend an overhead drop from an existing pole to a new pole.
- Removal and disposal of the electrical system currently serving the commercial fishing dock.
- Installation of a new electrical service.
- Installation of new dock distribution system including new shore power pedestals and power centers.

Specifications for the work to be done are described in detail in the attachments to this RFP.

**SUBMITTAL AND SELECTION PROCESS**

Respondents should address the following in submittals:

- Firm capability and experience in installation of shore power on commercial docks.
- Knowledge of permitting requirements applicable to shore power installation;
- Past experience and references in installation of commercial shore power;
- Proposed project schedule and bid for completing the shore power installation.
- Respondents should use the attached specifications and drawings when submitting bids.

Submittals should also include the following information: respondent name, phone, and fax numbers; name of Project Manager; and employees proposed to perform the project. Selection of a qualified respondent will be made by a Swinomish review panel based on evaluation of the above requirements. Drawings and specifications applicable to this project are available upon request from the below contact.

The Swinomish Indian Tribal Community expressly reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and the right to waive any informalities or irregularities in any bid or in any bidding and to further award the Project to the bidder whose proposal complies with the above and is deemed most responsive, as it best serves the interest of the Swinomish Indian Tribal Community. All bidders agree to be bound by their bids for a period of sixty (60) days following the below stated deadline for submittal.
